Lindsey Babcock noted that she is currently seeking clarification from the NCAA staff on this matter and will update the group when she receives additional information.

Mary Ellen also noted last year's confusion regarding the April contact period and the staff's subsequent clarification that it is permissible for coaches to evaluate at non-scholastic events that take place on a Saturday and Sunday only, regardless of where the event is located.
